 1. A motion is needed to appoint a Temporary President for reorganization purposes. (Note: Temporary President cannot be a newly elected or re-elected Board member. Eligible candidates are Mary Homan, Paul Adams or Gretchen Backer.
 2. Temporary President administers oath of office to newly elected and/or re-elected members – Gloria Smith, Jennifer Strickland & Taylor Warner (Region 1), Richard Jordan & Douglas Wilcox (Region 2), John Wood (Region 3) *“I do solemnly swear that I will support, obey and defend the Constitution of the United States and the Constitution of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, and that I will discharge the duties of my office with fidelity. I also swear that I live in my elected Region of the Montrose Area School District and will notify the President and Secretary of the Board within sixty (60) days if I should change my residence either to another region of the school district or outside of the school district.”*
 3. Temporary President calls for nominations for President of the Board of Directors for the ensuing year until the reorganization meeting in December 2022.
 4. A motion is needed to close nominations for the office of President of the Board of Directors.
 5. Election, by roll call vote in the order of nominations, is held for the office of President of the Board of Directors. New President takes office.
 6. New President calls for nominations for Vice-President of the Board of Directors for the ensuing year until the reorganization meeting in December 2022.
 7. A motion is needed to close nominations for the office of Vice-President of the Board of Directors.
 8. Election, by roll call vote in order of nominations, is held for the office of Vice-President of the Board of Directors. New Vice-President takes office.
